

Liability

A thing whose presence or behaviour will put something at a disadvantage, an amount of money owed, a responsibility for something

/laɪə'bɪlɪti/



A **noun**, plural or singular

Examples:

"The player is a **liability** to the team because of his poor performances" (noun)

"The **liabilities** of the business mean that it will struggle in the future"(noun)

"Lack of skills is a **liability** in the workplace" (noun)

Synonyms (same or similar meanings)

Obligation, duty, burden, responsibility, debt

Antonyms (opposite meanings)

Asset, irresponsibility, unaccountability
